

Nicker's Retreat Summer Camp Information:

- Summer camp runs from 9:00 am – 3pm, Monday – Friday
- We ask that you plan your drop-off in the morning no earlier than 8:50 am, and pick-up no later than 3:00 pm. Before and after care is available \$10 an hour, **please arrange in advance at info@nickersretreat.com**. Children that arrive early to camp without before care arranged need to be supervised by their parents until 8:50 am. Please do not allow the campers to enter the barns or pastures. Check in is typically in front of the garage and students are escorted to our classroom where they can store their personal belongings and enjoy a few moments of fellowship with other campers.
- On Monday – Thursday during summer camp weather permitting, we take the children that want to swim to the pool around 2:00pm. Parents can meet their children at the pool at 3pm. Children should bring their sunscreen, swimsuit, towel, and shoes that are easy to put on. **THERE IS NOT A CERTIFIED LIFE GUARD ON DUTY.** There will be an adult with the kids while they swim.
- Proper shoes (hard soled, enclosed toe) are required. If your child does not have the proper shoes, they will not be allowed to ride that day of camp.
- Long pants are recommended for mounted lessons. A change of clothes for other activities is also suggested. **HELMETS ARE SUPPLIED** or a personal bike or riding helmet works.
- Children should bring their own bag lunch, drinks and snacks. A refrigerator is available for food storage and beverages.
- We supply water but remember to pack all your sun protecting items, swimsuits, towels, extra shoes, and lunches! **PLEASE LABEL YOUR CHILD'S BELONGING WITH THEIR NAME!**
- **If your camper has an allergy, please tell us again, even if we already know!**
- Friday is our performance day. Each student will be assigned a specific time to show off what they have learned. All parents and family members and or friends are welcome to watch. It is a lot of fun.
